

## HENDERSON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT OFFERING H1N1 VACCINE

The Henderson County Health Department is offering a limited amount of the H1N1 injectable vaccine Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. **An appointment is required** & the vaccine will be provided at no charge. To make an appointment please call the Henderson County Health Department at (731) 968-8148.

The type of H1N1 flu vaccine being offered is injectable and will be offered to the following individuals:

- ALL persons aged 6 months through 24 years of age
- Persons living with or caregivers of infants < 6 months of age (e.g. parents, siblings, & daycare providers)
- Pregnant women
- Persons aged 25 through 64 with certain medical conditions
- Health-care workers & Emergency Medical Services Personnel

If you are not among these groups, you will not be able to receive the H1N1 injectable vaccine on these dates. However you may be eligible for the Flumist vaccine, which can be provided to healthy persons ages 2 – 49.

No shortage of 2009 H1N1 vaccine is expected. However, initially, only limited quantities and types of vaccine will be available. The Tennessee Department of health expects to receive enough H1N1 vaccine in coming weeks so anyone who wants to receive it, can do so.
